Montréal, August 16, 2016 — As the official presenter of [La Fête de la Musique de Tremblant](#), Quebecor is pleased to be part of the festivities for the 8th consecutive year. For this year's edition of the music fest, to be held from September 2 to 5, the line-up assembled by Angèle Dubeau will feature some 30 concerts covering the gamut from classical to jazz to world music. At the *Grande scène Québecor* stage, headliners will include Natalie MacMaster and Donnell Leahy in addition to Angèle Dubeau accompanied by her orchestra La Pietà and distinguished guests such as Shawn Phillips.

On the afternoon of September 3 and 4, prominent musician/composer **François Dompierre** will lead workshops at *Le Piano public Québecor* in which he will share his love of music and explain the ins-and-outs of musical creation. A well-known composer whose career has spanned more than 50 years, Dompierre has composed the scores for more than 60 films by directors such as Denys Arcand, Michel Brault, Jacques Godbout, André Melançon, Jean Beaudin and Léa Pool.
